


If you are in trouble or need help, you can turn to Jesus. He is with you and is able to help you. I pray God's blessings upon you in all you do in following Him.



Man's Problem - God's Solution

All are dead in sin unable to save themselves
Romans 3:10-18



A. REPENT FROM YOUR SINS

Luke 13:3; I tell you, nay: but except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

B. CONFESS YOUR SINS TO GOD

Romans 10:9-11; *That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth in Him shall not be ashamed.*

1 John 1:9; *That was the true light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.*

C. HAVE FAITH IN CHRIST

Ephesians 2: 8-9; *For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.*

D. SUBMIT TO THE LORDSHIP OF JESUS

Luke 9:23-24; *And He said to them all, if any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for My sake, the same shall save it.*

Now that you are born again, let's take a look at some good things that the Word of God does for us:

A. CAUSES FAITH TO GROW

Romans 10:17; ***So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.***

B. CONVICTS US OF SIN, SO WE KNOW WHEN WE ARE WRONG

Hebrews 4:12-13; ***For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. Neither is there any creature that is not manifested in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of Him with whom we have to do.***

C. HELPS THE CHRISTIAN TO DEAL WITH SINS COMMITTED

1 John 1:9; ***If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.***

D. HELPS KEEP US FROM SIN

Psalms 119:11; ***Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against Thee.***

E. GIVES US A STANDARD BY WHICH WE CAN GUIDE OUR LIVES

2 Timothy 3:16; ***All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.***

Water Baptism

Mark 16:15-16; ***and He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptised shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.***

The Bible says: ***those who believe AND are baptised shall be saved. It says more than just believe. Baptism is an important instruction straight from Jesus.***

Acts 2:38: ***Peter said, repent and be baptised in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.***

The Bible commands us to be baptised!

Colossians 2:12; ***Buried with Him in baptism wherein also ye are risen with Him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised Him from the dead.***

When you are baptised, the Bible says the evil person that you were, was buried in the water, and the new person who is in the likeness of Christ, comes out of the water.

Romans 6:5; ***For if we have been planted together in the likeness of His death, we shall also be in the likeness of His resurrection.***

Your old self passes away - it dies.

Am I Now Saved?

You need to know that you are saved, and that you do not have to keep getting saved.

A. HOW DO YOU KNOW THAT YOU ARE SAVED?

John 1:12; ***But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name.***

John 15:1-5; ***I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in Me that beareth not fruit He taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, He purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you. Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the Vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in Me. I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in Me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without Me ye can do nothing.***

2 Corinthians 5:17; ***Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things have become new.***

1 John 3:1-2; ***Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew Him not. Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is.***

B. WE SHOULD ENJOY CHRISTIANITY- NOT ENDURE IT!

Philippians 4:4; ***Rejoice in the Lord always; and again I say rejoice!***

Psalms 16:11 ***Thou wilt show me the path of life: in Thy presence is fullness of joy; at Thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.***

1 Peter 1:8; ***For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.***

Jude 1:24; ***Now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy,***

C. DO NOT RELY ON YOUR FEELINGS - BUT ON GOD'S WORD

2 Corinthians 5:17; *If any man be in Christ he is a new creature; old things have passed away, behold all things have become new.*

John 1:12; *But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name.*

John 6:37; *All that the Father giveth Me shall come to Me; and him that cometh to Me I will in no way cast out.*

Hebrews 10:17; *And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.*

1 John 1:9; *If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*

1 John 3:19-21; *And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before Him. For if our hearts condemn us, God is greater than our hearts, and knoweth all things. Beloved, if our hearts condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God.*

TRUST IN GOD'S WORD

Importance of Spirit Baptism

Acts 1:4-8; *And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith He, ye have heard of Me. For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence. When they therefore were come together, they asked of Him, saying, Lord wilt Thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel? And He said unto them, it is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in His own power. But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in*

Jerusalem and all Judea, and in Samaria and unto

The uttermost part of the earth.

Jesus commands His disciples to wait for the promise.

That's how important it was. What is the promise? The baptism with the Holy Spirit.

Why must they wait? To receive power so that they can become witnesses.

Acts 2:38; Then Peter said unto them, Repent and be

baptised every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

The Holy Spirit is a gift, a precious gift, given to us by Jesus. It is only for believers; those who are born again.

You must be born again to receive the Holy Spirit baptism.

Acts 2:4; ***And they were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave utterance.***

Acts 10:45-46; ***And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost. For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God.***

The people knew that Cornelius, the Gentile, had received the baptism with the Holy Spirit because he spoke in new tongues and magnified the Lord.

The **evidence** of the baptism with the Holy Spirit is speaking in new tongues. Speaking 'in tongues' is a heavenly language given to you by the Holy Spirit

Growing in God's Word

You must feed yourself on God's Word every day.

2 Timothy 2:15; ***Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.***

2 Timothy 3:15; ***And that from a child thou hast known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.***

Right Way

False Teachings

A. IT WILL PRODUCE A LIVING FAITH IN GOD.

Romans 10:17; ***So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.***

B. IT WILL CLEANSE AND PURIFY THE HEART

Psalm 119:9-11; *Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed thereto according to Thy word. With my whole heart have I sought Thee: O let me not wonder from Thy commandments. Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against Thee.*

C. IT WILL PROTECT FROM ERRORS AND FALSE TEACHING

Psalm 85:8; *I will hear what God the Lord will speak: for He will speak peace unto His people, and to His saints: but let them not turn again to folly.*

D. IT WILL BRING JOY AND REJOICING TO THE HEART

Jeremiah 15:16; *Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and Thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by Thy name, O Lord God of hosts.*


E. IT WILL MAKE US WISER THAN OUR TEACHERS

Psalm 119:99; *I have more understanding than all my teachers: for Thy testimonies are my meditation.*

F. IT WILL SPEAK PEACE TO THE TROUBLED HEART

Psalm 85:8; *I will hear what God the Lord will speak: for He will speak peace unto His people, and to His saints: but let them not turn again to folly.*

Christians should have a prayer time at home with the family.



Joshua 24:15; ***And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.***

Genesis 18:19; ***For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after Him, and they shall keep the way of the Lord, to do justice and judgment; that the Lord may bring upon Abraham that which He hath spoken of him.***

Deuteronomy 6:4-7; ***Hear, O Israel: the Lord our God is one Lord: And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: And thou shalt teach diligently unto thy children, shall talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.***

Straight after salvation, a Christian must join a local church and be fed on God's Word.

Jeremiah 3:15; ***And I will give you pastors according to Mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.***

Hebrews 10:25; ***Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one other: and so much the more as ye see the day approaching.***

Acts 4:31; ***And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together, and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the Word of God with boldness.***

You can also be fed God's Word by attending seminars and conferences.

Growing in God's Body

The body of Christ is made up of born again believers. As believers, we must flow in unity, and love one another, no matter what denominations others belong to.

As believers, we should be:

Praying for one another.

Bearing one another's burdens.

Speak the truth to each other in love.

Acts 4:32; ***They were all with one accord, sharing and helping one another.***

Colossians 2:1-7; ***For I would that ye knew what great conflict I have for you, and for them at Laodicea, and for as many as have not seen my face in the flesh; that their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ; in whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge; And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words; for though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the steadfastness of your faith in Christ; as ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in Him; rooted and built up in Him, and established in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.***

Ephesians 4:3-13; ***Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace; there is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in all. But unto everyone of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ. Wherefore He saith, when He ascended up on high, He led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men. Now that He ascended, what is it but that He also descended first into the lower parts of the earth? He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that He might fill all things. And He gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ. Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.***

Philippians 2:1-6; ***If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies, fulfil ye my joy, that ye be like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind, let each esteem others better than themselves. Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others. Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus. Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God.***

Growing in Prayer

A. WE NEED, FIRST OF ALL, TO THANK GOD FOR WHAT HE HAS DONE FOR

- 1) We should avoid complaining and murmuring.
- 2) We should thank God in advance for answers.

1 Thessalonians 5:18; ***In everything give thanks, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus, concerning you.***

B. WE NEED TO PRAY FOR ONE ANOTHER, EVEN IF WE DO NOT

Acts 4:28-32; ***For to do whatsoever Thy hand and Thy counsel determined before to be done. And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto Thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak Thy word, by stretching forth Thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of Thy holy Child Jesus. And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost. And they spake the word of God with boldness. And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things in common.***

Matthew 5:44; ***But I say unto you, love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you.***

C. WE MUST BE SPECIFIC IN PRAYER

When we ask, we must believe that we receive.

Matthew 7:7-8; ***Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.***

Hebrews 11:6; ***But without faith it is***

impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.

Mark 10:46-52; ***And they came to Jericho and as He went out of Jericho with His***

disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the high side begging. And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus Thou son of David, have mercy on me. And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried, the more a great deal, Thou son of David, have mercy on me. And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they called the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; He calleth thee. And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus. And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto Him, Lord, that I might receive my sight. And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.

1 John 5:14-15; *And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He heareth us: And if we know, that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him.*

Mark 11:24; *Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.*

D. WE SHOULD ALSO PRAY FOR CHURCH LEADERS AND ALL PEOPLE

2 Timothy 2:2; *And the things that thou hast heard of Me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.*

Hebrews 13:7-17; *Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation. Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever. Be not carried about with diverse and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein. We have an altar, whereof they have no right to eat which serve the tabernacle. For the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp. Wherefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered without the gate. Let us go forth therefore unto Him without the camp, bearing His reproach. For here have we no continuing city, but seek one to come. By Him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name. But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased. Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.*

Growing with One Another

Only in Christ will believers have genuine fellowship because the fellowship is centred upon the Lordship of Jesus.

A. IN FELLOWSHIP WE CAN PROFIT FROM OTHER CHRISTIANS'

1 Corinthians 14:26; ***How is it then, brethren? When ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying.***

B. IN FELLOWSHIP WE CAN FIND MUTUAL ENCOURAGEMENT

2 Corinthians 1:3-5; ***Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort; who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God. For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so our consolation also aboundeth by Christ.***

C. IN FELLOWSHIP WE HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY FOR GROUP PRAYER,

Act 4:29-31; ***And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak Thy word, by stretching forth Thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of Thy holy child Jesus. And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.***



D. IN FELLOWSHIP WE CAN KNOW EACH OTHER'S NEEDS, AND MEET

Acts 4:34-35; ***Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold, and laid them down at the apostles' feet: and distribution was made unto every man according as he had need.***

Galatians 6:2; ***Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.***

E. IN FELLOWSHIP WE ARE ONE REGARDLESS OF RACE OR COLOUR.

Galatians 3:26-28; ***For ye are all children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as have been baptised into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.***

Telling Others About Jesus

You need to tell others about the new life that is in you - wherever you are, whatever you do. We have seen that the Holy Spirit gives you power and makes you able to witness to others.

Mark 16:15; ***Go ye into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature.***
Matthew 28:19; ***Go ye therefore, and teach all the nations, baptising them in the Name of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost.***

Here are some points to remember:


Every Christian who is born again must witness for Jesus.

Acts 1:8; ***But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost parts of the earth.***

Christ should be the centre of your testimony.

Our witness should major in solutions and not problems.

We should avoid magnifying the devil in our witness, in our singing and in our testimonies.



Growing in Obedience to Jesus

As the body of Jesus, we must obey Him in everything we do. Many in the church are weak today through disobedience.

1 Samuel 15:22-23; ***And Samuel said, Hath the Lord delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, to hearken than the fat of rams. For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the Lord, He hath also rejected thee from being king.***

You are the one who chooses to obey God, or you can refuse to obey him. When you obey Jesus, Jesus knows He can rely on and trust you.

These are some areas in our lives in which we must obey Jesus:

A. IN PRIORITIES

Matthew 6:32; ***For your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.***

B. IN YOUR BODIES

Romans 12:1-3; ***I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.***

C. IN YOUR BUSINESS

Proverbs 3:6; *In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths.*

D. IN OUR HOMES

Ephesians 6:1; *Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.*

E. IN USING OUR TONGUES

James 3:5-6; *Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth! And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity; so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.*

F. IN OUR MINDS


Philippians 2:5; *Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus.*

G. IN THE USE OF OUR MONEY

1 Timothy 6:10; *For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.*

H. FOR HEALING

1 Peter 2:24; *Who His own self bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.*





Growing so People See the Fruits of the Spirit in Your Life

As a child of God you need to grow in these fruits. You have the fruits of the Spirit but you must grow in them, in order for them to operate in your life.

Every believer is given the same size and amount of fruit, so whenever one experiences love more than others, it is simply because he has grown more in love, not that he has been given more love than other Christians. Scriptures about the fruit of the Spirit are found in Galatians 5:22-23;

But the fruit of Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.



Accepting Jesus is the Beginning of a New Life

2 Corinthians 5:17; ***Therefore if any man be in Christ he is a new creature, old things have passed away, behold all things have become new.***

Now that you know that you are saved and are starting out a new life in Christ, you are as a new born baby. A baby needs to be fed in order to grow, you also need to be fed with the Word of God to grow spiritually.

As you grow in this life with Christ and in the knowledge of His Word, there are a few things you should do:

- A. Belong to a local church.
- B. Be baptised in water.
- C. Be baptised in the Spirit and power of the Holy Spirit.
- D. Grow in unity with others in the body of Christ.
- E. Grow in prayer.
- F. Grow in praise and worship.
- G. Grow in the Word of God.
